## **BAXTER HEALTHCARE, LIVERPOOL INNOVATION PARK, WAVERTREE, LIVERPOOL**

**22 JUNE 2010**

Baxter Healthcare has recently completed a new manufacturing and research and development facility at Liverpool Innovation Park where it makes drugs to fight chronic kidney failure. The 38,000 ft<sup>2</sup> plant is set to double the existing plant capacity of 1,650 tonnes per annum.

From the filtration perspective this new pharmaceutical facility built in accordance with cGMP is fascinating, incorporating many and varied unit operations, for product isolation, purification and bacterial removal along with a waste recovery system. The utilities use a purified water plant based upon membrane technology.

Air filtration in the facility includes HEPA filtration before the drying plant and bag filters after the plant for powder recovery and environmental protection.

We are delighted that Baxter Healthcare has kindly agreed to host a Technical Visit on 22 June. The visit is planned to start at 2 pm. Details of the location and the visit programme will be sent to all registrants. Due to the nature of the plant numbers are strictly limited so you are encouraged to register early!
